Since 2018, **MARE DI MUSICA – Festival of Music Schools** has been a leading reference point for music education in Italy, promoting young talents, cultural exchange, and cooperation among music institutions. The Festival has experienced exponential growth in both participation and prestige, expanding from **110 participants** in its first edition to over **1,600 in 2025**, becoming an event of national and international significance.

Thursday, June 11th, 2026

Morning/Afternoon: Arrival of groups and check-in at partner accommodations, distribution of the welcome kit.

Evening: Opening ceremony and inaugural concert in **Comacchio**, at **Piazzetta Trepponti**.

Friday, June 12th, 2026

Morning: Free time at the beach or cultural and nature activities at the **Parco del Delta del Po** (possibility of guided tours, boat excursions, etc.).

Lunch: Shared lunch in the city of **Comacchio** with an organized **jam session**.

Afternoon/Evening: Concerts in **Comacchio** and **Lidi di Comacchio**, held at the main venues of the area (squares, museums, open-air spaces).

Saturday, June 13th, 2026

Morning: Free time at the beach or cultural and nature activities at the **Parco del Delta del Po** (possibility of guided tours, boat excursions, etc.).

Afternoon/Evening: Concerts in **Comacchio** and **Lidi di Comacchio**, held at main venues of the area (squares, museums, open-air spaces).

Sunday, June 14th, 2026

6:00 a.m.: **Sunrise concerts** on the beaches near camping areas, followed by farewell greetings.

Morning/Afternoon: Departure of participating groups.



ASSISTANCE

All foreign ensembles will have a contact person during their stay to assist any possible way and ensure a satisfactory experience.

INSURANCE

Travel, health, and accident insurance, along with any insurance for instruments and equipment, must be independently managed by the participating music schools.

EMU PRIORITY ACCESS

The organization reserves 500 spots for schools presented by EMU, of which 150 are granted priority access to the EMU group “Onda Latina.”

REGISTRATION

First round: from October 30th to December 30th, 2025.

If additional spots are available, a second registration round will be opened.

Optional second round: from January 15th to April 30th, 2026.

Schools wishing to participate in the festival must register exclusively on the website www.maredimusica.it in the designated section and will have priority in the allocation of their requested accommodations.

PRICES

Registration for participation in the “**Mare di Musica 2026**” festival includes the “Mare di Musica Welcome Kit” and full-board accommodation (from dinner on June 11th to breakfast on June 14th) in bungalows or shared rooms with 4–5 beds, located in partner campsites, at a total cost of **€210** per person.

Full board includes meals a fixed menu (first course + main course + side dish + water – alcoholic beverages, liqueurs, and coffee excluded), with the possibility of requesting takeaway meals, as well as bed and bath linen, and unlimited Wi-Fi access. Participants will be accommodated in three camping, all with direct beach access and located within 10 km of Comacchio, for a total of approximately 500 beds.

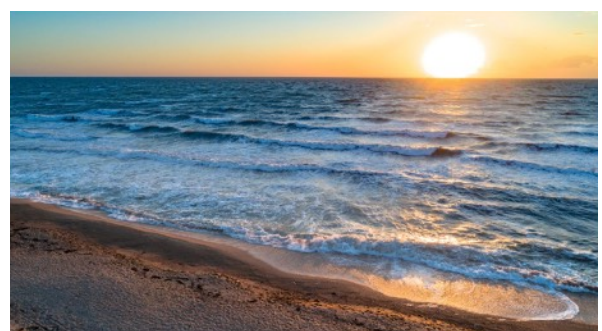
Not included: tourist tax (€1.20 per night for guests over 11 years old), extra linen changes, beverages, coffee, and anything not specifically mentioned.

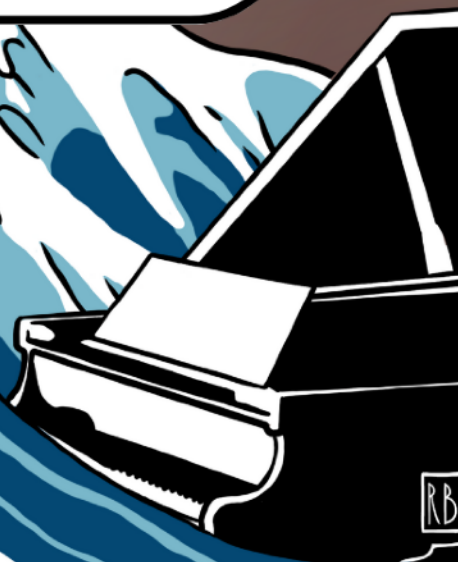
